RESPONSE TO THE INTRODUCTORY ISSUE., in July, of the MORFORD HISTORIAN, was gratifying. Many expressions such as "beautifully done .! .. a very nice job ... a pleasant surprise ... you are doing a great work ... most interesting ... delighted to receive the first issue of the quarterly ... you are making a great contribution ... anxious for October number ... it's a wonderful idea!" -- all made us feel it was well worth the effort.

Among our subscribers are 92 descendants of 16 of the early ancestral lines we listed in the July newsletter, all of whose lineage is known as far back as their 5th generation in America, and quite a few of whom are traced back to the first known Morfords in New Jersey. One subscriber is looking for an early "Munford" line; there is a gift subscription for the Minnesota Genealogical Society in St. Paul, by courtesy of Mrs. Joan Morford Bungum. Subscribers' names and their ancestral lines are shown beginning on page 16 of this issue.

One question asked was "How did you get my name and address?" We already knew many of them from previous correspondence with them or their relatives. We also had access to a computer print-out of Morford addresses from a so-called "Family Heritage Book". It is probable that many readers know of this book, the publishers of which are presently under investigation by the Consumer Protection division of the U. S. Postal Service. A study of the 670 names listed revealed many duplications, and at least 3 persons known to have been dead for ten years. About 18% of our- mailing was returned because of the inaccurate or outdated addresses. If the list had. included all Morford heads of families in this country, it would have been twice or three times as long as it was!

We hope not too many of our readers got stung by purchasing the book. One thing we can tell you is that the MORFORD HISTORIAN is no "scam" -- we have a lot of information on Morford family genealogies, and plan on sharing as much as possible in our quarterly, eventually culminating in the publication of some REAL books of the Morford heritage.

OUR THANKS to many subscribers, who sent us Xerox copies of family Bible records, news items, and photographs. Along with any such records sent should be included a copy of the title page, name of first owner of the Bible, name and address of present owner, a record of who has had custody of the book, and who made the entries in it. A record made contemporaneously with the event recorded is more reliable than those made long afterward, or which may have been copied from some older records.

WE APPRECIATE the photograph of a charcoal portrait of Thomas Morford [1819-1883], and his second wife, Orilla Bundy [1832-1905], of Hillsdale and Missaukee counties, Mich., sent by Paul B. Morford of Houghton Lake, Mich. We hope to reproduce this picture, in a future issue, along with some biographical data on his ancestors and descendants. Thomas' father was Garret Morford Sr. [1788-1873], said to have been one of 13 children (of whom only 5 are presently known) of Joseph Morford of Freehold, Monmouth County, New Jersey. Garret, and his brother Elkanah, served their Country in the War of 1812.

THANK YOU, Frances Miles Morford, for sending us a copy of the little booklet of poems by your mother-in-law, Elizabeth (Newlon) Morford [1872-1939]. "Lizzie", as she was called, was wife of Patrick Hagen⁸ Morford [1872-1938; *John Amoyt*⁷ *Isaac Newton*⁶ *James*⁵ *Daniel*⁴. Frances is the widow of John Joseph Morford [1906-1961], who was a school teacher in Florida before moving with his family to Santa Fe, New Mexico.

WEDDING BELLS will be ringing in Milan, Ill., December 27th, for Pamela¹⁰ Morford, of Taylor Ridge, Ill., daughter of Lossee and Esther (Clark) Morford, and Tony Whittington, son of Mr. & Mrs. Robert Whittington, Sherrard, Ill. Pamela's grand- father is Peter Lossee⁸ Morford [*William Locke*⁷ *Francis Marion*⁶ *Joseph*⁵ *John*⁴ *Thomas*³ ² *John*¹].

BECAUSE HE IS A SETTER FANCIER, Dr. Warren Newton Morford, of Chesapeake, Ohio, has a copy of A. F. Hochwalt's book, *The Modern Setter*, published in 1923, which mentions a strain of orange and white setters originated by Theodore Morford [1835-1908] of Newton, N.J., which enjoyed quite a vogue in the East during the early 1870s and 1880s, becoming well-known among various setter strains popular at that time. Theodore Morford was the grandfather of our subscriber Sam Morford of San Francisco, California, whose line goes back to Zebulon Morford [1722-1794]. Through Theodore's mother, Elsie deReimer, there is also a connection with the well-known Roosevelt family.

BELIEVE IT OR NOT, our subscriber Ted Morford, of Evergreen, Colorado, was featured in the Ripley column of that title, in 1976, when he was living in Newport Beach, Calif. The copy of the clipping he sent us shows Ted wearing a tiny lapel pin in the shape of an owl, the eyes being set with two pearls found by Ted in a bowl of oyster stew, when he was visiting in his home town, Manchester, Indiana. Ted is son of Wayne L.¹⁰ Morford [*Howard Clinton*⁹ *John Baird*⁸ *Jacob William*⁶ *John*⁵ *Thomas*⁴ 1737-1820].

THE EARLIEST KNOWN APPEARANCE of a name anything like MORFORD found in records of the New World, is the NATHAN MURFITT, age 23, listed among "Emigrants for St. Christophers" out of the Port of Limworth, 1634, to be transported in the "Falcon". In another ship(not named), also bound for the Barbadoes on 6 January 1634/5, the passenger list contains the name of THOMAS MARFUTT, age 22. Nothing-further has been discovered as to either of these early voyagers to this continent. It is not improbable that, having crossed the Atlantic, one or both may have reached the mainland on a vessel engaged in the coastal trade, which might not have been subject to any requirement of maintaining passenger list. It is interesting to note that in early New Jersey records, MORFORD records appeared in spelling variants quite similar to "Murfitt" and "Marfutt" such as "Morfit" and "Maurfoot".

A name somewhat similar to MORFORD is also found in Massachusetts records. In 1645, a William Brown of Salisbury married Elizabeth MUNFORD or MURFORD. Although no MURFORD males are shown in usual lists of New England settlers, such as Savage's *Genealogical Dictionary of New England*, that indispensable handbook does have this very interesting entry: "MULFORD, JOHN, Easthampton, L.I. 1650, one of the first sett. says Wood perhaps went home for some time, and came again in the Speedwell, 1656, from London, when the name appears MULFOOT." In England, the early spelling of Mulford is MOLFORD, the same variant shown in the 1802 deed whereby Cornelius Morford [1740-1825] sold his Salem Co., N.J. property before moving to Delaware. Salem records indicate that among founders of the Methodist Episcopal Church was a Cornelius "Mulford"; he is believed to have been the same person as Cornelius Morford, above. Some Mulford historians say adamantly that there is no possibility that the two names have a common origin; but can the interchange of spellings be laid strictly to error? Until an in-depth study of Mulford records is completed, this editor prefers to reserve judgment at this time.

Next we come to a record which may be significant in our search for the origin of New Jersey's MORFORD brothers. Skordas' *Early Settlers of Maryland* mentions a land grant made in 1663 to a JOHN MORFIT. This was less than nine years before the appearance in New Jersey of John and Thomas Morford, who obtained land grants in the Monmouth Patent. Might it be that these brothers were sons of the Maryland man?

Although Dr. John Stillwell's brief article on the Morford family, in his Volume IV, *Historical and Genealogical Miscellany, Early Settlers of New Jersey and their Descendants*, published 1916, commences with the statement that "Thomas and John Morford came from England and settled at Colt's Neck, Middletown nowhere is any evidence presented as to the date of their arrival, the place of disembarkment, or the name of the ship upon which they came. The basis for this statement may have been information imparted to Dr. Stillwell in personal interviews, or correspondence, with descendants of Morfords or other persons who were many generations removed from anyone having had *personal knowledge* of the family origin and history.

It seems much more likely that the Morford brothers were of the second, not the first, generation in the New World, and that they were among those first settlers who came *from other areas* of the colonies when New Jersey was opened to settlement. Settlers from Gravesend, L.I., were granted land known as the "Monmouth Patent", in April 1665. Stillwell also says that "Rhode Island ... furnished the Monmouth Tract with ... many of its settlers." Might it not be that Maryland, too, provided some who came into New Jersey a few years after 1665? More about this in our January issue -- don't miss it!

IF YOU ARE ENJOYING this newsletter, please recommend it to your Morford relatives --especially those who have custody of such family records as have been gathered on your branch of the family, or those you know have been doing some research into ancestral lines. Records may be shared, and preserved through publication in MORFORD HISTORIAN.

FAMILY TRADITIONS, handed down through many generations, may be useful to researchers, providing clues as to early origins, relationships, occupations, nationality or events of a family. Remember, though, that their accuracy after many retellings may become a bit distorted by the personal interpretations of each generation, especially if there is an interval of anywhere from one to three hundred years between the actual event and its latest recounting by a descendant. Time has a way of altering the tale, maybe embroidering the facts to impress the wide-eyed audience of children or grandchildren.

A TRADITION OF GERMAN ANCESTRY for one Joseph Morford (or Mofford) probably arose from the fact that his birthplace was given as "Berlin". Without further identification it was natural to assume he meant the town in Germany. But census enumerations showed he was born in Pennsylvania, which does have a village of that name, located in Brothers Valley Township, Somerset County. This Joseph Morford was of Muscatine, Iowa; married first to Harriet Bamford, who died in 1851, leaving children Hannah, born about 1844, and Riley, born about 1850. Joseph married 2d, in Oquawqua, Henderson Co., Ill., Permelia P. Westenhaver; children of this union were Omer (1855), Hattie Ann (1857), and Frances Preston. Descendants of Omer use the "Mofford" spelling, but in the 1856 Iowa state census the children of the first marriage were shown as "Moffett".

A MORFORD ON THE "MAYFLOWER"? No way! Passengers of that famous ship have been well researched, and nary a one of the 135+ Morford variant spellings is on the list. What had probably happened here is typical of many family traditions -- the story may be true, but has been transferred to the wrong family ancestor. Perhaps the wife of a descendant quite a way down the Morford line did have an ancestor who was among the brave band of Pilgrims who landed at Plymouth Rock 360 years ago this November; and whoever passed the story down thought it pertained to the Morford ancestor.

HOWARD BENJAMIN MORFORD, born 10 June 1909 at St. John, Kansas, died 8 June 1979 at Atlantic City Medical Center, Pomona, N.J. He was the-eldest brother of our subscriber Ralph Marion Morford of Leeds Point, N.J., and son of Amos Benjamin Morford [1883-1972] and his wife Emma Myrtle Williams [1891-1930] of St. John Kansas. Amos' father was Hiram Black Morford [1847-1886], who migrated from Greene Co., Pa. to Kansas by 1871.

M. ARNOLD MORFORD, of Indianapolis, Ind., died 9 June 1980 at 70 Cossell Road. Born 26 March 1913, he was the elder of two sons of Marion D. and Pearl (Lee) Morford, his lineage going back to John and Susanna (Hess) Morford. He is survived by his widow, Esther L. (Owen) Morford, a brother Gerald Lee Morford, a sister Clarice Genevieve (Mrs. Robt.) Pagel, and two daughters, Patricia Ann Newman and Sharon Lee Warner. He was a machine operator at FMC more than 35 years, a member of Wayne Township GOP, and a member of Chapel Rock Christian Church. Interment, Lincoln Gardens Cemetery.

MRS. WILLIE (MORRISON) HEDGCOCK, of Berlin, Bracken Co. Ky., died 26 June 1980, Maysville, Ky., aged 83. She was widow of the late Leslie Burr Hedgcock. Among survivors is a stepson, Mofford Hedgcock of Berlin, Ky., whose mother, Cora Ann Morford, was the first wife of Mr. Hedgcock. Cora Ann Morford was born 12 November 1877, daughter of Alexander Brown and Mary Frances (Bradford) Morford, and granddaughter of Jackie Black Morford [1817-1891].

FLOYD FERN MORFORD of Williamsfield, O., died 27 July 1980, aged 75. He was son of William Vance and Flora Adella (Logan) Morford. Survivors: His widow, Florence Anna Taylor; daughter Lee Ann (Mrs. Dennis E.) Burrows, Cortland, O.; 3 sons, Glenn T., Wm. Larry, James Milton, all of Wayne, O.; sister, Bonita Maude (Mrs. Lyle E.) Miner, of Wayne, O.; brother Merle Asbury Morford of Williamsfield, O.; 8 grandchildren; Deborah Ann, Roland Glenn, Stella Lynne, Dennis Larry, Leitha Grace, Jeffrey Floyd (all Morford) and Craig Eugene and Todd Alan Burrows.

HERE'S ONE OF THE MANY MORFORD MYSTERIES we'd like to solve. (You might know that all unfinished records "bug" a genealogical researcher.) Joel G. Morford [1834-1864], one of the grandsons of William and Sarah "Sally" Morford of Carlisle, Schoharie County, New York, married, in 1858, at Newark, Wayne County, N.Y., Anna Percy of Arcadia, N.Y.

Joel and Anna Morford had a son, Heman Percy Morford, born 17 September 1860 at Owatonna, Steele County, Minnesota, where Joel homesteaded with his brothers George and Joseph William. Heman was only four years old when his father died. Three years later, in 1867, his mother remarried, to a Civil War veteran, Fred C. Berg. By this marriage there were three daughters, Kate, Hattie L. and May, born to the Bergs between 1869 and 1876.

At the age of 22 or 23, Heman Percy Morford married, probably at Faribault, Rice County, Minnesota, Johanna (or Anna) Hoffranz. Their only child, a daughter named Eva Percy Morford (now Mrs. Karl Ohlhouse) was born in Faribault in 1884. In 1892, when Percy, as she is called, was about six years old, Anna and her husband separated. About 1894 Heman was believed to have been operating a restaurant, in Marshall, Calhoun County, Michigan; probably going under the assumed surname Herman.

Percy's last recollection of her father was when he was boarding a train. He planned to take care of his Michigan business, and then move to Salem, Mass., where he would work in a shoe store, not a factory. His death is said to have occurred about 1915 -but where? Had he remarried? Were there any children by the second marriage, if there was a second marriage? Were his last years happy ones? We would love to be able to learn the ending of this story!

CELEBRATION OF THE 80TH BIRTHDAY of Jane Grace (Penney) Morford, widow of Ralph Milton Morford of Paradise, California, brought some 75 family members together on the 27th of September 1980, including some who had not seen each other in years. A similar celebration was held four years ago for Jane's sister-in-law, Lois Ruth (Morford) Wheeler, at which a genealogical chart 12 feet wide was displayed on the wall and used as background for a photograph of all those present. Anderson L. Morford of Yuba City, California, who engineered the reproduction of the chart, sent a print to the Morford Historian, and last November he and his mother, Jane, visited the editor and her husband, bringing 4 large cardboards covered with pictures of Morfords who are descendants of Isaac Morford [1820-1896], of the Cornelius Morford line. These were copied, and many will be published eventually in one of the volumes of MORFORDS OF AMERICA, preserving them for future generations to enjoy. Great work, Andy!

WILLIAM RAY MORFORD, born 20 May 1884 in Johnson County, Iowa, son of John William and Stella Mae (Colt) Morford, and a descendant of James Morford [1766-1839] of Greene Co., Pa., is living in Ogden, Utah, with his wife, Retta (Hagerman) Morford, born 10 July 1892. They were married 16 December 1908, and are looking forward to celebration of their 72nd wedding anniversary soon! Their granddaughter, Mary Lou (Garrison) Netzer, of Puyallup, Washington, reports that all of their numerous descendants are living, and are planning to have a reunion in June 1981. Two of the couple's grandchildren, Kathy L. Hooke of Spokane, Washington, and Dennis W. Morford, of Anchorage, Alaska, are among subscribers of the MORFORD HISTORIAN.

INDEX TO THE TWO 1980 issues of MORFORD HISTORIAN will be sent free in January, to all who have subscribed by 31 December 1980; after that date the index will cost \$1.15.

MORFORD HISTORIAN SUBSCRIBERS are grouped here, according to their earliest known ancestor. Following each person's name are listed his parent, grandparent and so on; small numerals indicate generation to which each belongs. When a line has not been traced back to one of the two early Morfords of N.J. [*John*¹ or *Thomas*¹], we have determined approximate generation of known ancestor. Assuming 26 years to a generation, we deduct a series of 26s from the known date of an ancestor. *EXAMPLE*: Zebulon Morford [1722-1794] is assumed to have been son of a man born about 1696, and grandson of a man born about 1644, give or take a few years. As the early Morford brothers were adults in the 1670s, they must have been born about 1650-1660; Zebulon therefore must have been of the 3rd generation; Daniel [1741-1833] of the 4th generation, and so on.



THE PUZZLE OF THE 22-CHILDREN MORFORD FAMILY has mystified Morford researchers for a long time. By family tradition, the father of the children shown in the chart below had married twice, and sired a total of 22 children. (That leaves us with only 15 more to find!) We don't know whether these 7 were children of the first or second wife; nor when and where the father and his wives were born and died, much less what their names were. They appear to have been of Ohio when Ann and Margaret were born; of Kentucky when Betsey was born; and Ohio again in 1809 and 1813 when Joseph and Daniel were born. (A specific location for Joseph's birth is stated as Clermont Co., Ohio.) One of the children, probably an older one, used the spelling of "Maffett", and was of Kentucky in 1819 when his son John W. "Willie" Maffett was born. As to the children, Joseph married in Clermont Co., Ohio; but Butler Co., Ohio was the place of marriage for Margaret, in 1834, Elisha in 1838, and Betsey in 1840. By 1837 Daniel was of Franklin Co., Ind., where he married Mary Ramsey; they were of Bartholomew Co., Ind. in 1840 when their first child, John Alley Morford, was born. In 1850, Lewis and Margaret Emmons were living in Sugar Creek, Hancock Co., Ind., as neighbors to her brother, Joseph A. Morford and his wife Margaret. In 1860 the Emmons were at the same place, and their niece Caroline, age 13, was living with them. Margaret Emmons' sister Ann (Morford) Scudder was buried at Sugar Creek, in 1873.



MORFORD HISTORIAN will welcome any additional information about persons shown on this chart. Exact dates and places of deaths, or copies of obituary notices, will be especially helpful. Proof of names of the other 15 siblings (or half-siblings) of those above is required to identify where this family fits in with known branches of Morfords. Who knows the burial place, and age at death in 1842, of Miles Morford?
